Jamie,

At this point in time the Department is not requiring third party testing of skimmers, although it is highly recommended. As you pointed out, South Carolina DHEC does not have an approval process for manufactured products. The Department will evaluate the use of any proposed skimmer on a site-by-site basis. Based on my observations of the Marlee Float is capable of meeting the surface water withdrawal requirement in the NPDES Construction General Permit.
